# ATTENTION FOR PARENTS & STUDENTS

- The parents & Students are required to go through the Prospectus carefully before signing the Admission Form. Once the form is signed, the total responsibility of having read the rules and regulations shall lie upon the parents and students and they shall be bounded by the same.
- Attendance in the Class/House Test conducted by the college is compulsory.
   The college will take strict disciplinary action against a student, who is absent in the class/House Test.
- The students are required to fulfill the following eligibility conditions for appearing in the Annual University Examinations as per Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra rules.
  - a) Get 20% marks in aggregate of all the subjects and 15% marks in each subject in the house tests.
  - b) Attend 75% of the total lectures delivered in each of the subject offered by them including theory and Practicals.
  - c) Clear all the dues of the college.
- In case they fail to fulfill any of these conditions, they shall be detained from appearing in the final examination of K.U.K. It is the responsibility of the students to apprise their parents of all the rules and regulations.
- A fine of Rs.100/- per subject will be charged for absence from the test or house examination.
- All concession being given to the students will be cancelled if they fail or remain absent in the monthly test.
- Results of these tests will be sent to the parents/guardians.
- Condonation of shortage of lectures, upto 15% lectures attended, is principal's discretion meant for sports persons, students participation in NCC and Cultural activities and not a student's right.
- The name of a student, who remains absent for one week, without information
  will be struck off from the college rolls. Re-admission will be allowed on
  paying Re-admission fee of Rs.500/-.
- Any change in the address of the student or parent/guardian must be reported to the office without loss of time.

- The Principal can struck off the name of any student whose presence in the college in his opinion is against the discipline of the college.
- If any student wants to leave the college, he/she shall have to get permission of the Principal in black and white, otherwise he/she will have to pay the college fee and other funds for the whole Session.
- If a student fails to attend his/her classes for seven days from the date of commencement of the classes or from the date of admission, his/her admission shall be cancelled.
- The student must not conceal any information in the admission from otherwise his/her admission can be cancelled at any time.
- The decision of the Principal on any subject will be final.

Permission of joining late shall not be accepted as a justification for condoning shortage in lectures, provided that in case of a candidate who is allowed as a result of any change in the rules/ admission policy made by the University.

#### **FEE SCHEDULE**

Note: College dues will be intimated at the time of admission.

- 1. Always obtain a printed receipt for any amount deposited in the college office.
- 2. If a student gives college fees or admission fee to any other than the fee clerk, he/she will do so at his/her own risk and college will not be responsible for this.
- 3. Dates for depositing dues are regularly displayed on the college notice board & students will have to pay the dues on those dates. Otherwise, a fine at the rate of Rs.1/- per day will be charged.
- 4. If any student does not pay the dues till the end of the month, his/her name will be struck off from the college rolls.

#### **Absence from College**

If a student remains absent from his/her class Rs.5/- per lecture/day will charged.

College dues once paid will not be refundable in any case. The security is however, refundable as per rules of the college laid down in the prospectus.

#### Fee Concession/Book Concession

- 1. Economically poor but brilliant and intelligent students, good sports persons and holders of distinctions in co-curricular activities are provided free education facility.
- 2. Books are issued for the whole session to brilliant students.
- 3. For tuition fee concession, such students, will have to submit application form. Forms can be obtained from the college office. A notice in this regard is displayed on the notice board. Students seeking fee concession will have to appear for interview before the committee formed by the principal and only deserving students will be granted this concession.
- 4. These concession may be withdrawn at any time:
  - a) In case of any misconduct/misbehaviour by the student.
  - b) If the student does not appear or fails in House Examination or monthly tests.

#### **Eligibility Conditions**

For Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribes/Other Backward Classes

i) A student can get scholarship only once in a class. Failure shall not be eligible for the

- scholarship. In case of gap year study the concerned student will have to furnish affidavit on Rs. 10/- stamp paper duly attested by the Ist class magistrate.
- ii) Income Limit in case of Scheduled Caste Rs. 2,50,000/-, Scheduled Tribes Rs.2,00,000/- and other Backward Classes Rs. 1,00,000/-.
- iii) More than two brothers sisters shall not be eligible for the scholarship.
- iv) At least 70% attendance in each subject is required as per directions of Haryana Govt.If any student does not fulfill the condition of attendance his/her scholarship will not be paid by the Govt.

#### LIBRARY RULES

1. Library books are issued to every student on Library Cards. The number of books which a student can borrow will be as under:-

Under Graduate 02 Post Graduate 03

- 2. Meritorious students are allowed to get as many books issued from Library as are recommended by the Principal.
- Any loss of books should be immediately reported to the Librarian and the matter be settled within 10 days by either replacing the book or by paying cost of the book along with fine.
- 4. Books will be issued for a period of 14 days. Delay will entail a fine of Rs. 1/- per book per day.
- 5. Students on leave must arrange for the return of books in time.
- 6. Books issued from the library must be kept very carefully and in on case be underlined of disfigured. If the book is already damaged in any form, it should be brought to the notice of the Librarian before getting the book issued, otherwise, the person who returns the book will be held responsible for the damage.
- 7. Reference books, and periodicals shall not be issue except for consultation in the library premises.
- 8. Students must carry their Identity Cards with them whenever they enter the college Library. They can be denied admission to the Library or can be turned out of the Library if they fail to produce their identity cards on demands.
- 9. If an Identity Card is lost by any student a duplicate will be issued on payment of Rs. 100/-.
- 10. Students are expected to read the Notice issued from time to time by the Principal/Librarian. No excuse will be entertained for ignorance.

11. Students are expected to observe pindrop silence in the Reading Room and not disturb in any way.

#### **COLLEGE LEAVE RULES**

- 1. All leaves must be applied for in advance on leave forms available from the office on payment of Rs.5/-.
- 2. The maximum leave allowed to a student during the Semester will be 7 days only.
- 3. In case of serious illness, the leave application must be submitted as soon as possible along with the Medical Certificate.
- 4. When applying for leave, the students must have the Identity Card with them.

#### WITHDRAWAL OF COLLEGE SECURITY

Those students who want to get back their college security, may apply from Ist September to 28th February of the next academic session after leaving the college. The securities not withdrawn till 28th February will lapse. The Students should have paid all the college dues.

#### STUDENT AID FUND

There is a Students Aid Fund to help the deserving students. A lump sum aid is granted (a) pay college dues (b) pay examination fee and (c) purchase of books.

#### **IDENTITY CARD**

Every student of the college will be given an Identity Card. He/she will have to affix an attested, recent Passport size photo on it. Students should always keep their Identity Card with them. In case Identity Card can be issued on payment of Rs.100/- to the college office. Students will have to lodge complaint in the Police Station. No one can use the identity card of the others. Students are to bring their Identity Card in college daily. Identity Cards can be checked by any member of the staff at any time.

#### INTERNAL ASSESSMENT

#### For Under Graduate Courses

Internal assessment in all UG courses be increased from 10% of 20% in each theory paper based on the following criteria:

#### **SPECIAL FEATURES**

#### **Sports**

Sport and games are very significant for harmonious development of personality of students. So they are expected to participate in one or more games. Ample Provision exists on the college campus for various games and sports such as Hockey, Football, Cricket, Basketball, Badminton, Weightlifting, Power Lifting, Body Building, Volleyball, Table Tennis and Athletics. The facility of Gym is provided for proper training of sports & games. The college participates in University sports and other organized tournaments. Athletic Meet is held in college every year in the month of February.

# NATIONAL CADET CORPS (N.C.C.)

The college is known for the emphasis it lays on N.C.C. training. The college has been allowed one platoon of 54 Cadets by 10 Haryana Battalion, N.C.C. Kurukshetra. A whole time N.C.C. Officer looks after the training and administration of N.C.C. in the college. Qualification in N.C.C. proves useful to the students in their future career. Some seats are reserved in P.G. Classes for 'C' certificate holders. Recently Haryana Govt. has granted 5 marks to 'C' Certificate holders in the selection of Assistant Professors in colleges. Our cadets have been participating regularly in different training camps like Advance Leadership Camp, Rock Climbing, Regular Army Attachment Camp etc.

#### NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (N.S.S.)

The college started N.S.S. in the year 1983. The main emphasis is to develop the all round personality of the students. They are expected to be patriotic responsible citizens. The college has been allotted two units of 100 volunteers each. A large number of students take part in various activities conducted under N.S.S. umbrella.Our college volunteers are being regularly selected for Republic Day Parade, a rare honour to the college. Our college has got top positions in the University for its extension activities.

#### **CULTURAL ACTIVITIES**

Special emphasis is given on overall personality development of the students. They are encouraged to take part in cultural activities like debates, dance, music, dramas, educational tours and various other activities.

#### WOMEN CELL

College has a women cell, which helps the girl students in removing their day to day problems and guides them in related matters. Women cell is being looked after by a senior female teacher.

#### **COLLEGE LIBRARY**

The college library is richly equipped with more than 16,000 books, on variety of subjects including text books and reference books. There are separate reading rooms for girls and boys. Reading rooms are provided with a large number of newspapers, periodicals and journals. The library has been fully computerized. Science Encyclopedia on C.D. Rom and Encyclopedia of Britannica on paper are also available in the library.

#### CHEEKANCHAL

The college magazine "CHEEKANCHAL" is under an Editorial Board of consisting of members of the staff and the students. The students are encouraged to contribute articles to the magazine. It gives an opportunity for self expression to the students in English, Hindi, Sanskrit and Punjabi. Each section has a student editor working under the guidance of the staff editor.

#### **ALUMNI ASSOCIATION**

To maintain strong emotional attachment or bond with old students of the college, 'Alumni Association' has been formed in the college. Each year a number of new members join the association. The get together of the old students is arranged in the college every year.

# UNIVERSITY EMPLOYMENT INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE BUREAU, KURUKSHETRA

In collaboration with the Department of Employment Information and Guidance Bureau, Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra is running the bureau to assist students in choosing the career/courses in the University Campus. The main functions of the Bureau are:-

- i) To provide information and guidance on educational / vocational matters.
- ii) To register professional graduates and all persons holding Master's Degree with at least 50% marks for employment assistance.
- iii) To prepare guidance literature to help students in connection with giving them some training & direction for competitive examination.
- iv) To impart information & motivation to un-employed educated youth to adopt self employment as an alternative to the paid employment.

The Career information room in Arts Faculty Building is equipped with appropriate material of occupational training facilities, higher education in India & abroad, fellow ships/scholarship, competitive examination etc.

A Fortnightly bulletin "Vocational Guide" is issued by the Bureau to disseminate information on current opportunities for employment educational and vocational training, scholarship/fellowships and on topics of general interests of the students.

Students are advised to take advantage of the facilities available at bureau which remains open on all working days.

**Place of litigation with the university.** All legal disputes relating to examination & admission of students will be subject to Kurukshetra courts or having Jurisdiction in Kurukshetra.

**Special Note:** If any student remains ABSENT or FAIL to submit the Examination Form to appear in 1st / 3rd/5th Semester's examination during the academic session, he/she will be not be eligible to appear in 2nd/4th/6th Semester's Examination.


